DIRECTIONS

7000 Olson Road, Union, Illinois 60180, in McHenry County

From Chicago:

Take the Jane Addams Tollway (Interstate 90) to U.S. Route 20, Marengo Exit 42. Turn left on Route 20 and drive about 4 ½ miles to South Union Road, turn right, Follow South Union Road until it ends at West Union Road and turn right. Take this road through town to Olson Road and turn right.


From Milwaukee and Eastern Wisconsin:

Take Interstate 43 west to U.S. Route 14. Follow U.S. Route 14 south to Illinois Route 23 south to Illinois Route 176, turn left, follow to North Union Road, turn right. Or take any road south to Illinois Route 176 follow west to North Union Road, turn left go into town. The stop sign is Jefferson Street, turn left. Take this road through town to Olson Road and turn right.

From Rockford and Western Wisconsin:

Take U.S. Route 20 (or Interstate 90 and exit at Route 20 at Cherry Valley-Belvidere) through Marengo. About 1 mile east of Marengo, turn left on South Union Road. Take South Union Road through Union to Olson Road and turn right.
